Music in Today's Service

Jean Berger's setting of Psalm 47 is based on a text from the 1640 Bay Psalm Book, the first book printed by the Puritans of Massachusetts: "Clap hands, all people, shout for joy, to God with voice of singing mirth: For high Jehovah fearful is, a great King over all the earth...Sing psalms to God, Unto our King with singing voice For God is King of all the earth." *Hold Fast to Dreams*, by living jazz legend Dave Brubeck, is based on a text by Langston Hughes (1902-1967): "Last night I dreamt this most strange dream, And every where I saw What did not seem could ever be: Hold fast to dreams For if dreams die Life is a broken-winged bird That can not fly. Hold fast to dreams For when dreams go Life is a barren field Frozen with snow."
